Distribution of Vaccination Tickets for 3rd Dose of Covid-19 Vaccine

3回目接種の接種券を送付します

The city has begun mailing out vaccination tickets for the 3rd dose of the Covid-19 vaccine in order of eligibility. Individuals who have received their vaccination ticket in the mail may make a reservation to receive their vaccine. Please see the information pamphlet enclosed with your vaccination ticket for information on how to make a reservation online (available 24 hours) or by phone via the reservation hotline (0120-050-503).

- Children under the age of 18 are not yet eligible to receive a 3rd dose.
- Individuals may receive their 3rd dose if 6 months or more have passed since receiving the 2nd dose.
- Vaccination tickets can be expected to arrive between 2-5 days after shipment.
- An especially high volume of vaccine tickets are scheduled to be mailed on March 11th, so it may take up to 10 days for those tickets to arrive due to the high number of tickets being mailed.

• If your vaccination does not arrive by the expected date, please confirm the date you received your 2nd vaccination and contact the City Coronavirus Consultation Call Center. \mathbf{B} (0570-026-263)

- Vaccination tickets have already been mailed out to the following people:
- Residents ages 65 and over who completed their 2nd vaccination before August 31st, 2021.
- Residents between the age of 18 and 64 who completed their 2nd vaccination before July 31st, 2021.

Regarding Vaccine Brands

For the 3rd dose, Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are available.

Many people have reported less severe side effects from the Moderna vaccine after their 3rd dose compared to the 2nd dose.

For the 3rd round of vaccinations, the amount of Moderna vaccines available is about half of what was available during distribution of the first two doses. The ratio of vaccines that the city has received is about 55% Pfizer and 45% Moderna. Currently, it is slightly easier to make a reservation for the Moderna vaccine, so those wishing to receive their vaccine as soon as possible are advised to choose Moderna.

Information for Those Who Wish to Receive Their 1st or 2nd Dose

For those wishing to receive their 1st or 2nd dose of the vaccine, please contact the reservation hotline at (2 0120-050-503). We will assist you in selecting an inoculation venue and scheduling an appointment.

•When making a reservation, you will need the ticket number printed on your vaccine ticket. Please have the number ready before making a reservation.

• It is no longer possible to make reservations for the 1st or 2nd dose via the online reservation system. Please make a reservation using the telephone hotline.

• The deadline to receive the coronavirus vaccine free of charge is September 30th, 2022. Those who wish to receive the vaccine are advised to make an appointment as soon as possible.

Information Regarding Children's Vaccination

•Please select one of the medical institutions listed below when making a reservation. Reservations cannot be made directly with individual clinics. Please use the online reservation system or the reservation hotline.

•The Pfizer brand children's vaccine will be used for children ages 5 to 11.

•The time and dates available for inoculation will vary by medical institution. Please be sure to double check your appointment time.

• The list of available medical institutions is subject to change.

•Due to limitations with vaccine availability and scheduling, it may be difficult to receive the vaccine at your first choice medical institution. The reservation timeline may also be adjusted depending on the vaccine supply.

• Vaccination is not mandatory. A parent or guardian who is familiar with their child's health condition should carefully read over the benefits and drawbacks of vaccination (detailed below) before deciding whether to vaccinate their child.

Benefits and Drawbacks of Vaccinating Young Children Against Covid-19

The primary benefit of the coronavirus vaccine is that those infected with Covid-19 experience symptoms that are typically much milder than unvaccinated individuals. The potential drawbacks to receiving the vaccine include mild soreness around the injection site, headache, and/or a fever during the evening or day following inoculation. However, the side effects of the vaccine are mild in most people, and usually disappear completely after a few days. At present, there is no evidence to suggest any long-lasting negative health impacts from the vaccine.

Other Covid-19 Information 新型コロナウイルス感染症に関する情報

Aizu Wakamatsu city experienced its highest number of cases to date on February 5th, with a total of 54 new cases confirmed in one day. In addition, the current wave of coronavirus infections includes more children and younger individuals than in previous waves, leading to several clusters at schools and daycare centers.

Standard infection prevention measures such as wearing a mask, washing, and sanitizing hands, and avoiding the "3 C's" are still effective against the omicron variant, so we ask for everyone's cooperation in observing these protective practices.

Isolation Period for Close Contacts Shortened

Based on scientific evidence that the Omicron variant has a shorter incubation period than previous variants, the national government has reduced the number of quarantine days required for those who have been in close contact with an infected person. The last date of contact with the infected person will be considered "Day 0," and quarantine will be required during the following 7 days.

However, those deemed to be "essential workers" may be exempt from the 7-day quarantine if they present a negative Covid-19 test. Essential workers include medical professionals, caregivers, and workers needed to maintain social infrastructure such as first responders and postal workers.

Who is considered a "Close Contact"?

Close contacts are individuals who have spent an extended period of time interacting with an infected person at close range, resulting in a higher risk of infection. Examples of close contact include those living in the same household as an infected person, as well as those who have spent 15 minutes or more in conversation with an infected person without the use of masks. The close contact period is counted two days prior to the onset of symptoms in the infected person. In the case of asymptomatic individuals, close contacts are counted to two days prior to the sample collection date on the infected person's PCR test.

Financial Support for School Closures, Childcare, etc.

The national government has announced that a financial subsidy will be available for parents or guardians who have incurred costs due to Covid-19 between August 1st, 2021, and March 31st, 2022. Parents or guardians who had to take paid leave from work, take an extended leave of absence, or arrange alternative childcare due to school closures or a child's Covid-19 infection may be eligible for financial compensation.

Remember to Register Your Change of Address! 住所が変わったら届け出を!

If you move to a new residence, it's important to register your change of address. If you forget to register your change of address, it may become difficult to receive pension payment or other public benefits and services. Failure to register a change of address may also impact the delivery of election ballots, children's school enrollment notifications, vaccine reservation documents, health information, etc. Following a change of address, it is also necessary to update your MyNumber Card information, Health insurance details, childcare subsidies and more. Please do not forget to register your change of address with each necessary administration. Throughout the months of March and April, the consultation window in the Citizen's Division office will be open on Saturdays and Sundays, and weekday hours will be extended, so please take advantage of the extended opening hours. <u>Please Bring Proof of Identification for Procedures at</u> <u>City Hall</u>

In order to prevent identity theft and falsified accounts via stolen Residence Certificates and health insurance documents, the city is asking for proof of identity when handling procedures at city offices. Please remember to bring proof of identity such as a MyNumber Card, a valid driver's license, a passport, or other official document. Those acting as representatives for another person must also show proof of identity.

If you are acting as a representative for another person or handling multiple accounts at once, you must provide a letter of appointment from the person whose accounts are being handled. There are some procedures that cannot be conducted by a representative, so please confirm with the relevant office beforehand.

Please Register Your Own Personal Seal

Your personal seal, or "inkan," is an important item used for registering accounts and processing financial loans. As such, you must register your own personal seal. Seals cannot be registered by a representative. To register your seal, please bring an official form of photo identification and the seal you wish to register. A certificate of registration will be distributed to you on the same day. Seal registration can be done at various city offices including the Citizen's Division of City Hall, the Kita-Aizu office, the Kawahigashi office, the Minato Community Center, and the Otomachi Community Center.

▼ Caution: If you do not have a valid form of photo ID, or you are unable to register your own seal, please contact the appropriate office ahead of time to consult about registration procedures. A personal seal registration form is needed to apply for a Personal Seal Registration Certificate. Personal Seal registration procedures can be carried out at any city hall branch office and local civic

center. Branch offices will not have seasonal extended office hours.

▼List of Available City Hall Procedures: Moving in/ Moving out procedures, Residence Certificate (jumin-hyo) issuance, issuance of documents related to Family Register, Personal Seal Registration Certificate issuance, Enrollment in National Health Insurance / cancellation of insurance, issuance of insurance card, enrollment in National Pension Service, cancellation of pension (excluding dependent pensioners), Pensioner Status Report form, issuance of Maternal and Child Health Book, issuance of Tax Payment Certificate, etc.

City offices are extremely busy during March and April. For individuals who only need to obtain a certificate or document from the city office, please consider utilizing the document services at your local convenience store. Please note that a valid MyNumber Card or Basic Resident Register Card is needed to utilize convenience store document services.

Please keep the following points in mind to prevent fires in your neighborhood.

▼ 4 Fire-prevention Habits: Never smoke in bed or allow others to smoke when they might fall asleep. Don't leave flammable objects near the oven or stovetop. Never leave an open flame unattended when using a stove or cooktop. Make sure electrical outlets don't get dusty and unplug cords from the outlet when not in use.

▼ 6 Fire-prevention Measures: Use ovens and stovetops that come with a built-in safety device. Be sure to regularly inspect your household fire alarms and replace them every 10 years. Choose fire-resistant furniture and curtains when possible. Place fire extinguishers around the home and make sure you know how to use them in case of an emergency. Plan and rehearse an evacuation route. Assist with fire prevention efforts in your neighborhood.
