Let's Prepare For Disasters

災害に備えよう

You never know when a disaster will occur, so it's important to remain prepared. One thing you can do to protect yourself is to talk to your family and neighbors about ways to respond to natural disasters. You should also confirm important details with materials such as a hazard map or a household disaster preparedness chart.

House and Room Check

Check and confirm that there are no dangerous places in your home and be sure to fix anything that could pose a danger to your household. In the event of an earthquake, be sure to arrange your rooms in such a way that it prevents objects and furniture from falling, creating safe spaces within your home.

▶Checkpoints...

- Do not place large furniture close to doors
- Be sure to fix furniture securely where you sleep to prevent it from falling
- Refrain from putting objects such as sofas against glass windows etc.

Confirm Your Emergency Evacuation Site and Evacuation Shelter

Be sure to confirm with your family beforehand about the location of designated evacuation shelters. Also research other safe places that might serve as alternate shelters, such as the homes of relatives and acquaintances, Japanese-style inns and hotels, and public establishments.

- **Emergency Evacuation Site...** A designated area to seek refuge in times of emergencies to protect your life; usually outdoors
- **Evacuation Shelter...** A designated place to live in the event one's home is compromised in a disaster

★Emergency Evacuation Shelter

In the event of inclement conditions such as heavy wind and rain or an earthquake, move to your designated Evacuation Shelter once it is safe to do so.

Stock Up on Disaster Preparedness Supplies

You can prepare necessary items from your day-to-day life.

▶ Prepare in your home ©drinkable water, groceries ©comfortable shoes ©rain gear ©flashlight/electric
torch Ohelmet Owork gloves Oblanket Ofirst-aid kit Oportable toilet etc.
▶ Put in an Emergency Bag ©masks ©disinfecting wipes ©rechargeable batteries ©household medicine
Oportable radio Oemergency rations (candies, chocolate, etc.) Obatteries etc.
▶ Keep in Accessible Places ©registered seal ©driver's license ©health insurance card ©bankbook



Home Stockpile Points

A good way to prepare for natural disasters is to implement a practice called "rolling stock," which is stockpiling extra daily necessities in case of an unexpected emergency. You thereby maintain a constant stock of emergency foods that you use on a daily basis, preventing any of your stock from expiring.

• Groceries = 3 meals per day \times number of people \times 3 days (\times)

Oprescription notebook/medical history Odaily medicine etc.

- Drinkable water = 3 liters per day \times number of people \times 3 days (%)
- Fuel = portable stove, solid fuel, gas canisters, etc.
- Supplies for infants, babies, and very young children = baby formula, disposable diapers, etc.
- * 1 week preferable

Watch Out for Accidents During Snow Removal

除雪中の事故に注意しましょう

Due to incidents such as falling from roofs and ladders, falling into waterways, becoming caught in snowblowers, and snow falling from roofs, injuries to senior citizens are increasing. Precautions such as the wearing of helmets and safety ropes as well as performing tasks with a partner are encouraged for accident prevention. For those who use snowblowers, carefully inspect your machine and be sure to stop the engine when removing any clogging from packed snow. Also, if there is any possibility of an accident or illness during snow removal, keep a smartphone or cell phone on your person.
